## Managing Behaviours At Home and School Workshop

Dr Grant Sinnamon, a registered Psychologist, who's clinical focus is in the area of clinical mental health and neurorehabilitation in the context of childhood Brain Development will be visiting Townsville to host a Managing Behaviour Workshop where he will introduce the REPAIR model to help navigate behaviour and the window of tolerance for children with higher needs.

In the workshop Dr Sinnamon will introduce attendees to the REPAIR model; the foundations of neurodevelopment, and the factors that are important to understand and consider when caring for and assisting children with a neurodevelopmental disorder or an acquired condition that has impacted neurodevelopmental and neurological function.

REPAIR model offers a guide for parents, professionals and care support staff dealing with challenging behaviour in children with Autism, ADHD and other neurodevelopment disorders.
