Student Arrivals and Departures

An Important Reminder: Students **MUST** be signed in and out of the office or pick up zones each morning and afternoon. If you wish to collect your student from their classroom during school hours, you are responsible to go through the administration building and alert the office staff to sign your student out. If you collect your student after 2.35pm from the classroom or other area, you must go out through a pick up zone or the admin building to ensure staff have signed them out for you.

The small gate at the far end of P Block will no longer be an option for parents to use as access to the school to ensure all students are signed out through the staff at the pick up zone. It will be remaining locked throughout the day and afternoon pick up time. This is effective immediately.
