This funding will be used to

- Increase the % of students demonstrating progress against the TCLC developmental writing checklist.
- Every conventional reader will progress within and across PM benchmark levels.
- Increase the implementation average in the annual SET Plan for the whole school approach to Positive Behaviour for Learning (PBL).

Our initiatives include

- Support teachers and leadership teams to effectively use PM data to inform the teaching of reading.
- Professional development and coaching to develop teachers' understandings and skills for:
 - progressing writing skills
 - developing comprehension skills for conventional readers
- Education for parents to develop their understanding of early reading, and writing and how to support these emergent skills at home.
- Embed the Gradual Release of Responsibility Pedagogical Framework in reading.
- Professional training and coaching to develop consistent PBL practices across the school.
- Review Tier 1 PBL structures and practices.
- Develop resources to support school wide Tier 1 PBL practices.
- Align and embed the teaching and reporting of behaviour expectations with the Personal and Social Capabilities.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Establish a resource room. (Furnishings, Resources \$5,000**)
- Develop and provide resources to support reading, writing and PBL. (Resources \$10,000**, Teacher Aide \$70,000**)
- Provide targeted professional learning supported by planning, modelling, observation and feedback processes. (TRS \$15,000**)
- Foster professional learning in the teaching of reading, writing and PBL. (Networking, PD \$6,000**)
- Provide targeted professional development of skills for staff delivering programs supporting PBL practices. (Training \$9,500**)
